

Computer & Internet Policy

The use of computers, the Internet and other technology resources is a privilege. Inappropriate use will result in a cancellation of that privilege. The teacher/principal and/or school board will decide if any usage is inappropriate and their decision is final. We have adopted this policy for the safety and protection of all our students.

1) Games

Loading and/or playing games of any kind on any of the school's computers is considered vandalism and is prohibited.

2) Data

The malicious attempt to harm or destroy data of any student, teacher, the school or any other party is considered vandalism and is prohibited.

3) Computer Room Etiquette

- a) Internet use will be under the supervision of a teacher at all times
- b) Do not disrupt the network, the data, or other users.
- c) Keep things neat, clean and in order.
- d) Responsible use of materials in the computer room (computers, printers, chairs, paper, etc.) is expected and required.

4) Warranties

The school will not be responsible for any damages suffered including loss of data or for the accuracy or quality of information obtained through our equipment.

5) Security

When a security problem is identified (inappropriate Pop-ups, etc.) notify the teacher immediately.

6) Acceptance of Terms and Conditions

All terms and conditions as stated in this document are applicable to all users

7) Privileges

The privilege to use computers, networks, etc. may be suspended or terminated at any time deemed necessary.
